Do NOT send money now. Upon approval, you will be asked to sign a Release of Liability agreement to attend the event, and then provided an Official Program with a detailed map included. **You will be contacted by email if your application is approved.** Money will be used to help finance the BBQ's on Saturday and Sunday, and all attendees will receive a 4GB flash drive containing all event photos and shots of the eclipse that are taken over the weekend by the Adventure Books' staff. A full-length video of the event will be uploaded to YouTube. **Event is restricted to people 21 and over, no exceptions.** All information collected in this application will be kept strictly confidential by the Adventure Books staff and will be shredded after the event. You will be contacted within two weeks on the status of your application. There are a few ground rules.

1) You can bring an RV to the event, but the use of powered generators at the campsite is not allowed, and there are no dump facilities onsite. Most people will use tents or stay in their cars. If you must run your generator, you will have to move your RV away from the main campsite. However, you will not lose your campsite if you wish to go to town, run your generator, or the like. Sites are assigned for the entire event.

2) **No shooting guns anywhere near the main campsite.** If you want to target-shoot, (it's allowed in the National Forests) you must go at least a mile from camp to do so.

3) We understand people party a bit when they go camping. No problem there. We only ask you don't go crazy on people, otherwise you will be asked to leave.

4) Since the event happens in August, campfires are probably going to be restricted. Adventure Books staff is planning a propane-powered alternative for night use.
